Since Presidio Bank's founding in 2006 Mr. Woolwine has served as Chairman of the Board of Directors. Mr. Woolwine has over 40 years of experience in banking with a focus on corporate and private banking services in Chicago, Boston, Los Angeles and San Francisco. He is the former Chairman of Golden Gate Bank in San Francisco, where he was a member of the group that acquired the bank in 1984 and became President of the bank in 1985. Golden Gate Bank became a subsidiary of Greater Bay Bancorp, a \$7 billion Bay Area bank holding company, which was subsequently sold to Wells Fargo. Prior to this he headed Bank of California's Northern California Banking Division from 1979 to 1984. Previously, he worked for First Chicago from 1972 to 1979, where his last position held was that of Senior Vice President and head of the Los Angeles Regional Office.

Mr. Woolwine has served as past Chairman of the Board for the San Francisco Chamber of Commerce and served on the Boards of Delta Dental of California, Saint Francis Memorial Hospital, the San Francisco Boys and Girls Club, the Senior Olympic Games, the Bay Area Sports Organizing Committee and the Bay Area Sports Hall of Fame. He currently serves on the Board of Western Independent Bankers, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl and sits on the Board of Regents of the Hanna Boys Center.

Mr. Woolwine obtained his B.A. from the University of Notre Dame and his M.B.A. in Finance from the University of Chicago.
