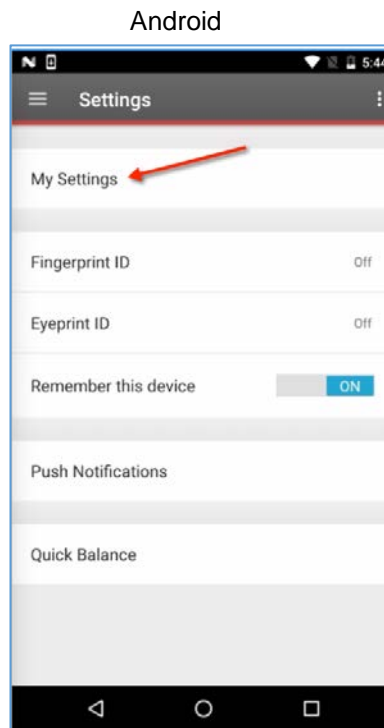
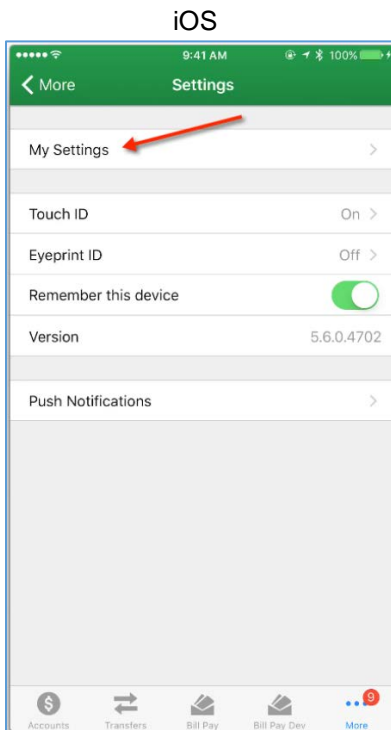
Please update your app in the app store to version 5.6 in order for the following new features to be available on your device. Although our targeted live date is scheduled for September 18, 2017, some app stores may be delayed in allowing version 5.6 to be immediately available, so it may take some app stores a few days to fully implement version 5.6.

GENERAL ENHANCEMENTS

User Setting Enhancement

You can now manage your account settings. The settings screen is the same one used within eBanking.

1. Open the “More” tab on iOS or the Sidebar navigation on Android and tap on “Settings”
2. Tap on “My Settings”
 - a. The text for “My Settings” will match what you have in eBanking



NOTE: The “Additional Settings” menu within the account settings page will not be available within the app. You must log in to eBanking to make changes to “Rename & Hide Accounts”, “Alerts & Notifications” and “Text Banking”

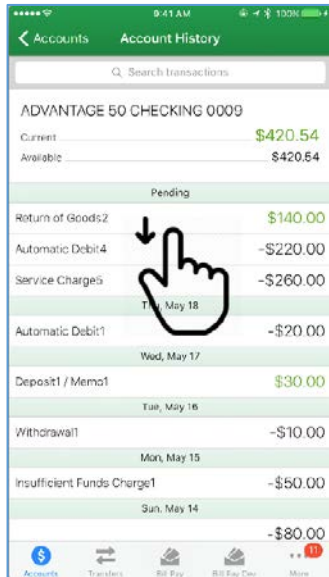

Transaction Search

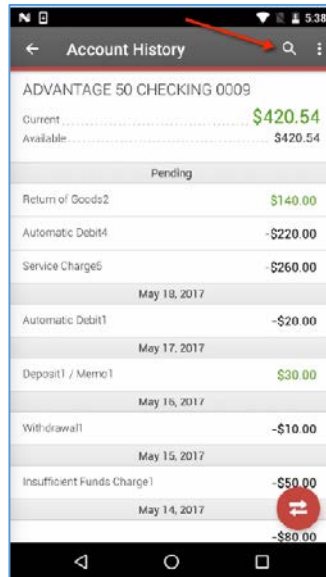
You can now search your transaction history like you can in eBanking.

1. While on the transactions page, drag down the transaction view (for iOS) or tap on the Magnifying Glass icon (for Android) to show the search bar.

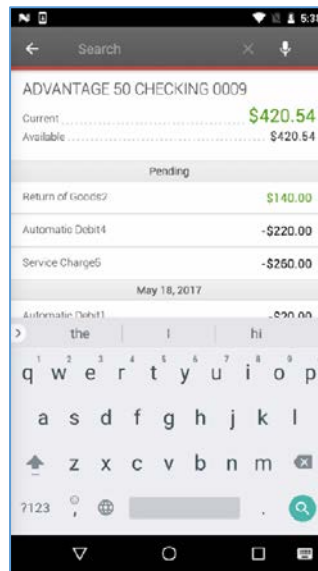
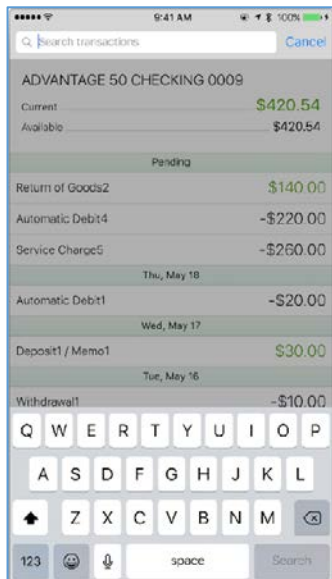

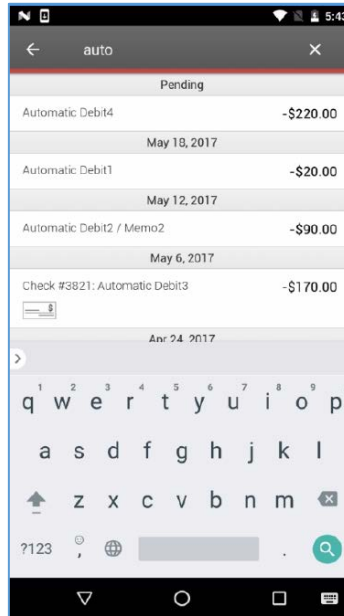
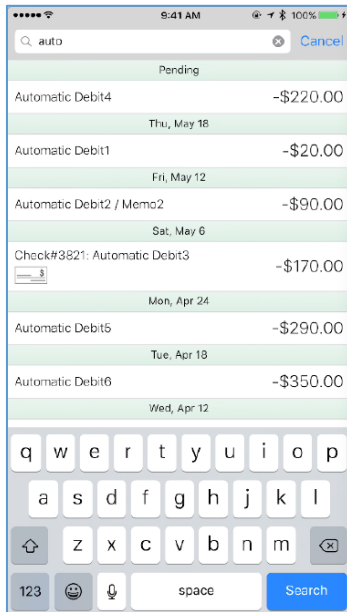


2. Enter the desired search term or amount and tap search. The matching transactions will be shown to you.

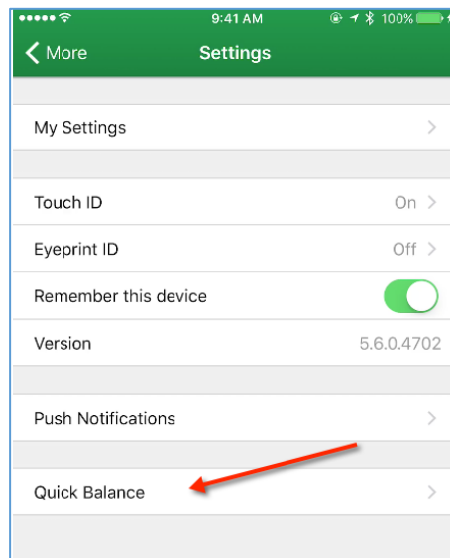


iOS Specific Enhancements

Quick Balance, Widget and Apple Watch Update

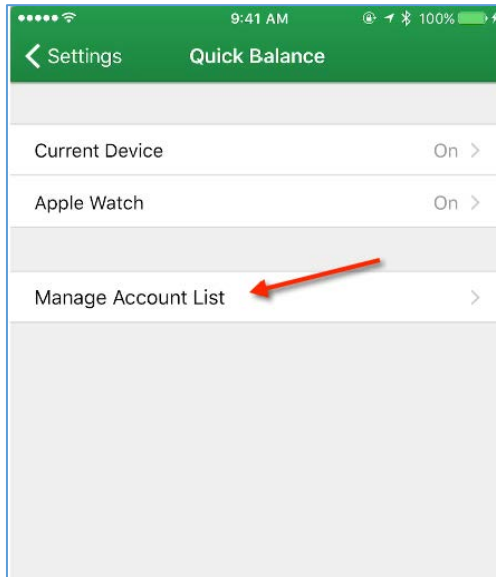
Enhancements were made to the Quick Balance, Widget and Apple Watch functionality to allow you to reorder and hide account across all three features.

1. To hide or reorder accounts, navigate to the “Settings” page, and tap on “Quick Balance”

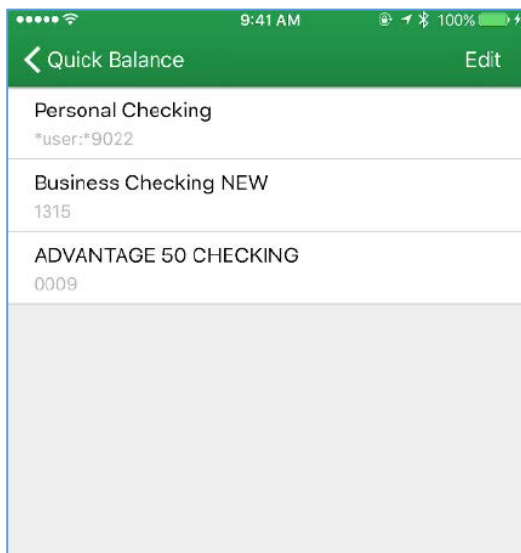

2. Once there, tap on “Manage Account List”
 - a. Please Note: “Manager Account List” will only be shown in the menu if you have enabled either “Current Device or “Apple Watch”

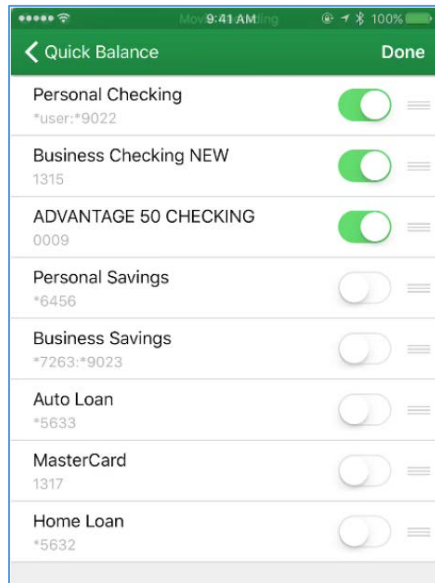


3. You will be able to see how the accounts are ordered and what accounts will be displayed on the Widget, Quick Balance and Apple Watch.



4. To make changes to the sort order or hidden accounts, you will need to tap on “Edit” in the upper right.
5. Accounts may be rearranged by dragging and dropping each account row. You can also hide or show accounts by toggling the on/off switch. Once all the changes are complete, you can tap “Done” in the upper right.

Android Widget v2

A refresh button was added and a list view was implemented that matches what you have in your iOS Widget. You may also fetch updated balances without having to wait for the 12-hour refresh period.
